- If you are considering divorce in Washington State, then here are three basic things you will need to know.
- Washington is a "no-fault" state. None of the courts will determine which spouse is at fault. Only one spouse has to say and prove that the marriage is "irretrievably broken."
 - Washington is a "community property" state. All the property acquired during the marriage is subject to division between both of the spouses. This applies to debt, as well. Washington is also a "fair and
- equitable" state. All the property and liabilities are divided into a "fair and equitable" manner, which doesn't always mean property and liabilities are divided **"50/50".**


